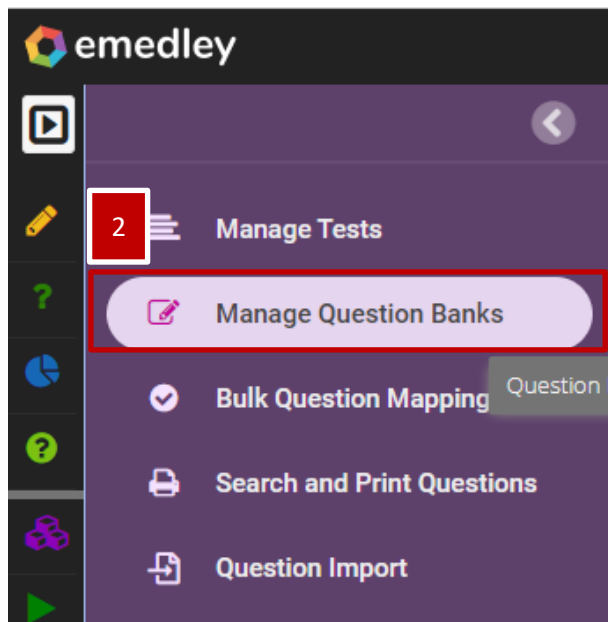
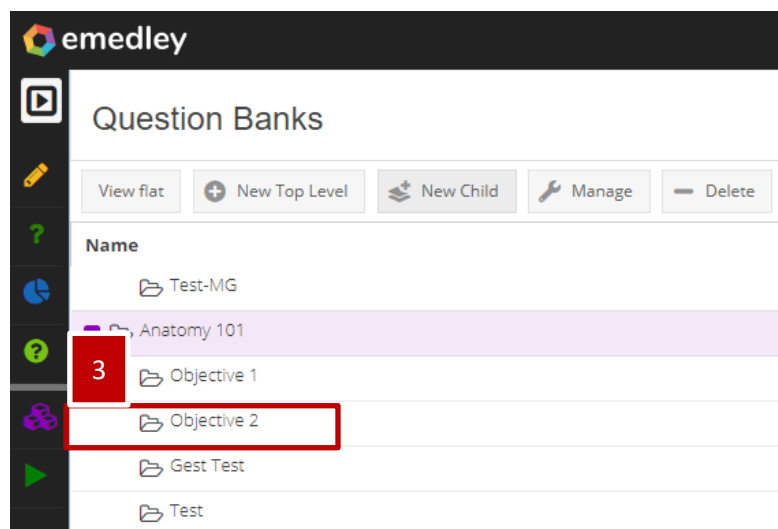


eMedley: How to Create Scenario Based Question

1. Log on to <https://he.emedley.com/uhcom>

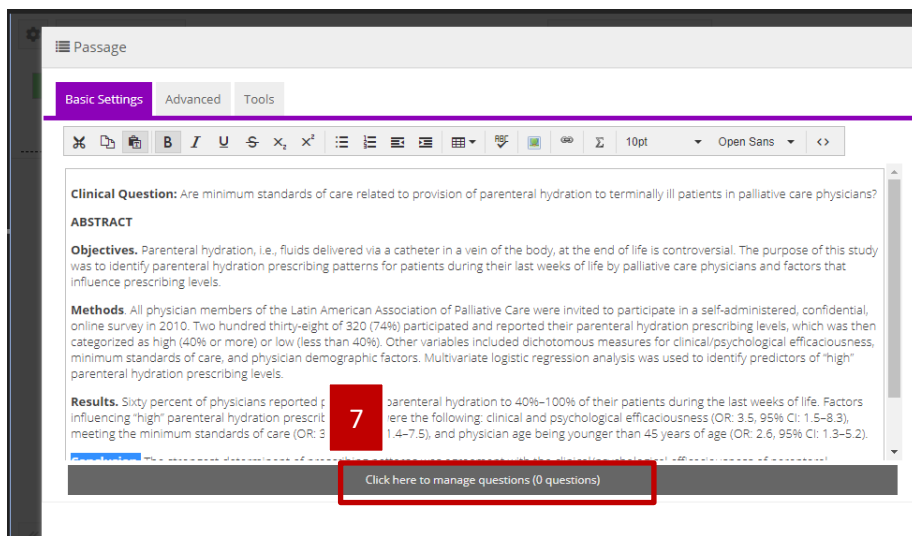

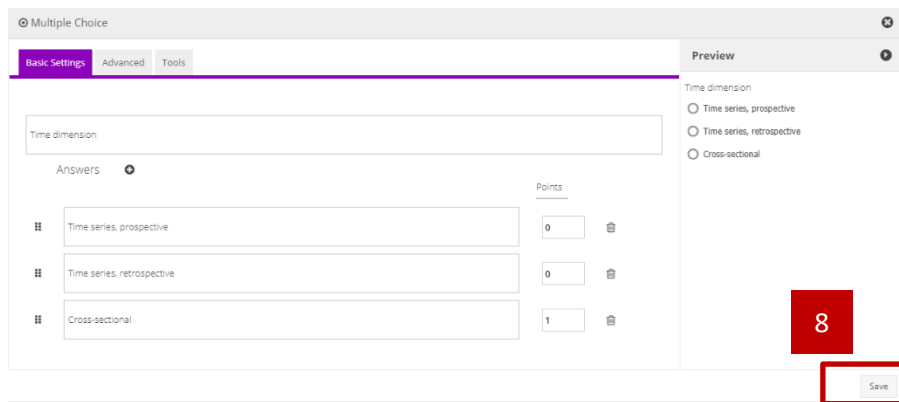

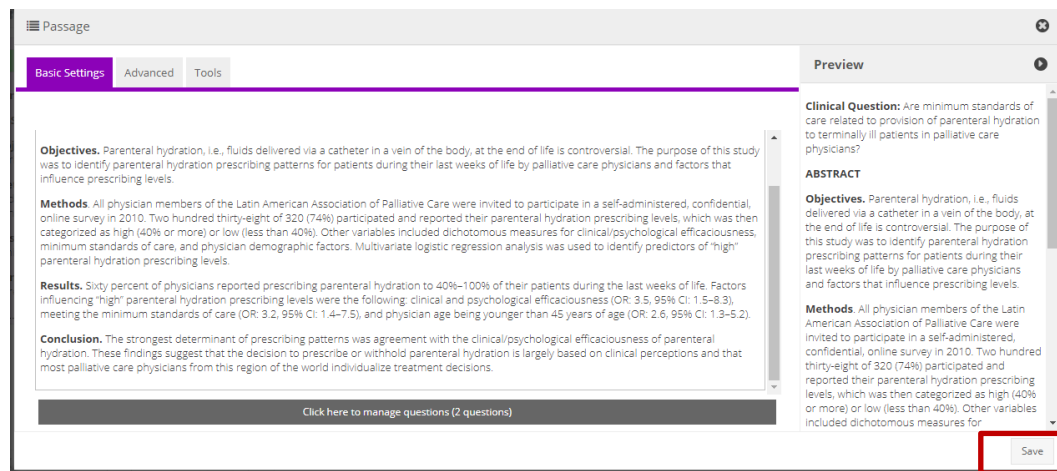
